The majority of NHS acute organisations are Foundation Trusts, who have additional freedoms and can tailor their governance arrangements to the individual circumstances of their community and health economy, and also generate a certain level of income through in-house private health services. Independent sector hospitals can provide services to the NHS at NHS prices.
C2	Surveillance authority	The independent regulation of the quality and safety of care offered by health care providers in England is undertaken by the Care Quality Commission. The regulation of the market in health care services is by NHS Improvement, in relation to Foundation Trusts, and the Department of Health.
